

Admissions Procedure

1. Fill-out the school questionnaire. Contact the school office for a copy.
2. The office will respond to the questionnaire and setup an interview with our School Administrators if necessary.
 - a. The interview will include the parent(s) or guardian(s).
 - b. Prospective students entering sixth grade or above will be interviewed as well.
 - c. A tour will be given of the school grounds.
3. You will be asked to read the Student/Parent Handbook to assure agreement with our policies.
4. If necessary, your child may be tested to assure proper placement in certain classes.
5. Complete and turn in the following Registration Forms:
 - a. Student Registration/Application
 - b. Statement of Agreement with the Student/Parent Handbook
6. Once your child has received a Letter of Acceptance, you will also need to complete the following:
 - a. Medical Certificate (copy of birth certificate, immunization records, and recent physical)
 - b. Family Insurance Card
 - c. Payment Option Form
 - d. Transportation Reimbursement Form (if you qualify—based on age and home location—one per child)
 - e. Transcripts Request Form
7. Submit your Registration Fee.
8. Order uniforms from Land's End. (Note: All polo shirts and jumpers **must** be ordered from Land's End.)
